
Summary:

At approximately 1:38 P.M. on January 24, 2017 Clinton Police and Clinton Fire responded to Shell Central, 401 2nd Avenue South to a report of a man shot. Upon arrival authorities found the victim had fled the scene. A 35 year old adult male victim was later located at a residence in the 200 block of 2nd Avenue South with a single gunshot wound. The victim was transported to Mercy Medical Center for treatment. The injury was not life threatening.

At approximately 3:33 P.M. Officers responded to the area of the 300 block of 1st Avenue and the 300 block of 2nd Avenue South for a reported shooting. Officers located a 26 year old male in the 300 block of 2nd Avenue South who was the victim of a gunshot wound. The victim was transported by Clinton Fire to Mercy Medical Center for treatment.

At this time the identities of the victims are not being released.
