**Incident:** Wanted Subject

**Date:** January 12, 2017

Shortly after 9:00 a.m. on January 12, 2017, agents from the Division of Criminal Investigation requested assistance from the Clinton Police Department in the apprehension of a wanted subject fleeing on foot from the Wild Rose Casino. As DCI agents pursued, the subject ran into Walmart, 2715 S 25<sup>th</sup> St. A perimeter was established around Walmart and the store was put on lock down with all customers and employees being evacuated. A thorough search was conducted with the assistance of Walmart security and the subject, who was hiding in a merchandise display, was apprehended.
