MEDIA RELEASE

The 2017 B-rrry Scurry is being held on Saturday, February 4, 2017. The race course will be closed to all vehicular traffic from 12:00 P.M. (noon) to 1:30 P.M. Exceptions to this closure will be made for persons living along the race route. Those persons will be allowed to <u>cautiously</u> exit and enter the course. All other traffic will be directed away from the race course. Vehicles traveling on all north/south streets between South 5th Street and Argyle Court can expect extended delays when attempting to cross 5th Avenue South.

The race course will be as follows:

Start - Lincoln Blvd in front of Clinton Community College

Northeast on Lincoln Blvd. to 8th Avenue South & South 10th Street

East on 8th Avenue South to South 9th Street

North on South 9th Street to 5th Avenue South

East on 5th Avenue South to South 5th Street

North on South 5th Street to 3rd Avenue South

West on 3rd Avenue South to South 7th Street

South on South 7th Street to 4th Avenue South

East on 4th Avenue South into the 500 block of 4th Avenue South

At a designated point in the 500 block of 4th Avenue South the runners/walkers will turn around and retrace the route back to the finish line on Lincoln Blvd. in front of the Clinton Community College.

Participants in the B-rrry Scurry will have preference to motor vehicle traffic. Officers will be located at major intersections. However, they may not be able to expeditiously allow vehicles to cross 5th Avenue South. Extended delays can be expected between 11:45 A.M. to 1:30 P.M.

The Clinton Police Department recommends the motoring public take advantage of Bluff Blvd. and other north/south streets east of South 5th Street. When traveling westbound, motorists are encouraged to use 2nd Avenue South and avoid those streets between 3rd Avenue South and 6th Avenue South from South 5th Street to Argyle Court.
