- Stop serving alcoholic drinks at the end of the third quarter.
- Ensure that your guests have a designated driver or call a local taxi service.

If you are attending a Super Bowl Party...

- If attending with a family member or friend, determine ahead of time who will be the designated driver.
- Eat and snack during the game.
- If drinking alcoholic beverages, pace yourself. Alternate with non-alcoholic drinks.
- If you have too much to drink, ask a sober family member or friend for a ride home.
- Keep an eye on others. If you feel someone has had too much to drink, don't let them drive. Remember the old saying, "Friends don't let friends drive drunk."
- On the trip home, wear your seatbelt.
