Incident: Assault with a pickaxe
Date: February 10, 2017
Location: Gazebo Antiques & Collectibles
256 Main Avenue
Clinton, Iowa

Summary:

At approximately 3:00 p.m. on February 10, 2017 Clinton Police and Fire were called to Gazebo Antiques & Collectibles, 256 Main Avenue, Clinton for a woman assaulting a business owner with a pickaxe.

Officers arrived and determined that a female had entered the store and grabbed a pickaxe and began swinging it breaking items inside the store. She struck the store owner multiple times with the pickaxe causing serious injury. The owner was transported to Mercy Medical Center by Ambulance.

The suspect fled the business and a citizen who was at a business next door tackled the suspect and held her until police arrived.

During the investigation, it was determined the suspect had caused damage to another building and vehicle at 122 Main Avenue just prior to the incident at Gazebo Antiques & Collectibles.

As a result, Cassandra R. Doran, age 25, of Clinton was charged with the following:

Willful Injury Causing Serious Injury
Burglary 3rd Degree
Criminal Mischief 2nd Degree (three counts)

Criminal charges are merely an accusation, and all defendants are presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.

The case remains under investigation by the Clinton Police Department.
